Biển cổ Thánh Mẫu Fatima là một biển cổ Thánh Mẫu lịch sử trọng đại nhất và khảm trang nhất trong các biển cổ Thánh Mẫu từ trước đến nay trong Giáo Hội cũng như trên thế giới. Tại vì Biển Cổ Fatima và Sứ Điệp Fatima là những gì liên quan đến chẳng những sự vụ của riêng Giáo Hội Chúa Kitô trên trần gian thời hậu hai Thế Chiến I và II, mà còn đến vận mệnh chung của thế giới loài người nữa, như đã thực sự xảy ra trong lịch sử vào hậu bán thế kỷ 20.

Tuy nhiên, không phải biển cổ Nước Nga đã trở lại ngày 25/12/1991 là Sứ Điệp Fatima đã trở thành lỗi thời, trôi lại, từ ngày đó, lịch sử thế giới lại càng ngày càng ứng nghiệm hơn với những gì đã được tiết lộ trong Bí Mật Fatima được Mẹ Maria cho 3 thiếu nhi thụ khai biết vào ngày 13/7/1917. Thế giới này sẽ đi về đâu và như thế nào, đều đã được gói ghém kín đáo trong Bí Mật Fatima phần thứ ba, phần bí mật đã được Đức Thánh Cha Gioan Phaolô II cho tiết lộ vào ngày 26/6/2000, và còn được Đức Thánh Cha Biển Đức XVI đường như đã tiên báo một cách linh ứng nào đó ở Linh Địa Fatima ngày 13/5/2010.

Có thể nói, căn cứ vào diễn tiến lịch sử và chính sứ điệp của mình, Fatima chính là đạo khước mở màn cho thời điểm của Lòng Thương Xót Chúa, một thời điểm được chính Đức Thánh Cha Phanxicô công nhận đã có từ thời Đức Thánh Cha Gioan Phaolô II, và là một thời điểm được ngài thời thúc Giáo Hội hãy trở thành một bệnh viện lưu động hay bệnh viện dã chiến (a field hospital) để băng bó biết bao nhiêu là thương tích của con người trong một thời đại đang chẳng những sống trong cơn bão lốc văn hóa chết chóc mà còn trong trận văn hóa tận số nữa (terminal culture).

Không biết có liên hệ gì với nhau hay chăng mà Năm Thánh Thương Xót 2016 được Đức Thánh Cha Phanxicô mở ra ngay trước Năm Thánh Mẫu Fatima 2017. Nhưng chắc chắn một điều là chẳng có gì tình cờ ngẫu nhiên theo sự quan phòng thần linh của Đấng làm chủ lịch sử thế giới loài người. Và ngày 13/5/2017, thời điểm kỷ niệm biển cổ Thánh Mẫu Fatima Bách Chu Niên (1917-2017), Đức Thánh Cha Phanxicô, Vị Giáo Hoàng mở Năm Thánh Thương Xót ngoại lệ 2016 sẽ đến Linh Địa Thánh Mẫu Fatima để chủ sự mừng 100 năm biển cổ Thánh Mẫu trọng đại và hết sức khảm trang này.

Nhóm Tông Đồ Chúa Tinh Thương sẽ dĩ thực hiện cuộc Hành Hương được gọi là "Fatima Lòng Thương Xót Chúa", chủ đề cho các cuộc tĩnh tâm trong năm 2017 do Nhóm TDCTT chủ trương và thực hiện, không phải chỉ để cùng với Giáo Hội, qua vị giáo hoàng đại diện Chúa Kitô, mừng Biển Cổ Thánh Mẫu Fatima Bách Chu Niên, mà còn nhờ dịp này xin Thánh Mẫu Thương Xót Maria ở Fatima, vị đã cảm nghiệm được LTXC hơn ai hết, giúp cho mọi phần tử và mỗi phần tử TDCTT cũng được chia sẻ phần nào LTXC như Mẹ và với Mẹ, nhờ đó, họ có thể loan truyền LTXC trong thời điểm của lòng thương xót ngày nay, bằng chứng từ thực sự của Linh Đạo Thương Xót: "Giêsu ơi, con tin nơi Chúa!"

WED, MAY 10 – NEW YORK/ACROSS THE ATLANTIC

Depart New York on board your overnight transatlantic jet flight. En route enjoy dinner followed by a full-length movie.

THU, MAY 11 – ARRIVE LISBON/FATIMA AREA

Start your inspiring Anniversary pilgrimage in Lisbon where you will enjoy a brief orientation tour (*time permitting*) before you depart for the village of Fatima, the world's most famous Marian shrine. Overnight in the Fatima area for the next three nights. (D)

FRI, MAY 12 – FATIMA/SANTAREM

Here, on the thirteenth of each month between May and October in 1917, the Blessed Mother appeared to three young children and exhorted the world to pray for world peace. Visit the Basilica of Our Lady of Fatima, site of Francisco and Jacinta's graves, and the Little Chapel of Apparitions with the statue of "Our Lady of Fatima." Free time for devotion and worship. This afternoon drive to nearby Santarem, and visit the Church of the Holy Miracle (Igreja do Santissimo Milagre), home to a 13th-century eucharistic miracle. (B,D)

SAT, MAY 13 – FATIMA - CELEBRATION OF THE ANNIVERSARY OF THE FIRST FATIMA APPARITIONS

Today is at leisure to join in the celebration of the 100th Anniversary of Our Holy Mother's Apparitions. (B,D)

SUN, MAY 14 – FATIMA/SALAMANCA/BURGOS

This morning head to Salamanca where you will visit Alba de Tormes, one of the most important pilgrimage centers in Spain. See the Carmelite Convent where the preserved body of St Theresa lies. Then continue your journey to Burgos where you will overnight. (B,D)



MON, MAY 15 – BURGOS/LOURDES

Visit the gothic cathedral dedicated to the Blessed Virgin. Begun in the 13th century and completed in 1567, it is renowned for its immense size and unique architecture. Then on to the shrine city of Lourdes, where the Blessed Virgin Mary appeared to the poor shepherd girl, Bernadette, a total of 18 times. (B,D)

TUE, MAY 16 – LOURDES

Between February 11 and July 16, 1858, the Virgin Mary appeared in the Grotto of Massabielle to the poor shepherd girl Bernadette, a total of 18 times. Scratching the ground as instructed by the Virgin, Bernadette saw a miraculous spring well up where none had existed before. Today, Lourdes is the most important shrine to Our Lady. Visit the Grotto of Apparitions, Basilica of the Immaculate Conception, Basilica of St. Pius X, and Way of the Cross over the hillside. This afternoon visit the Miracle Baths with free time for reflection and devotion. Attend the Blessed Sacrament Procession, the Blessing of the Sick and the famous Torchlight Procession, if available. (B,D)

WED, MAY 17 – LOURDES/CARCASSONE/AVIGNON

Drive to Tarbes and proceed through the province of Languedoc to Carcassone, the greatest fortress city in Europe. In the 8th century, the city withstood a siege by Charlemagne for five years. Some of the fortifying walls still standing were built by the Romans in the 3rd and 4th centuries. Continue to Avignon in the Provence region. Six French Popes reigned here before the Papacy was returned to Rome in 1377. (B,D)

THU, MAY 18 – AVIGNON/LASALLETT-FALLAUAUX/ ARS-SUR-FROMANS

On your morning tour of Avignon, visit the imposing Palace of the Popes, a magnificent example of medieval architecture, and Notre Dame Cathedral. Drive to La Salette-Fallavaux and visit the sanctuary of Our Lady of La Salette in the mountains above the village where in 1846 two children reported a Marian apparition. Continue to Ars-sur-Fromans where you will see intact the church of Saint Sixtus, rebuilt by the Holy Priest of Ars, St. John Vianney. Overnight in the area. (B,D)

FRI, MAY 19 – ARS-SUR-FROMANS/NEVERS/ ALENCON AREA

Drive to Nevers, where St. Bernadette lived and died after 18 apparitions of the Virgin Mary in Lourdes. Visit St. Gildard Convent and view St. Bernadette's tomb. Continue to Alencon, the birthplace of Saint Therese. Overnight in the Alencon area. (B,D)

SAT, MAY 20 – ALENCON AREA/PARIS

This morning continue your journey to Paris, the "City of Light." This afternoon enjoy a one-hour cruise on the Seine River. (B,D)

SUN, MAY 21 – PARIS

Your morning tour of Paris will include many of the famous landmarks recognized throughout the world such as the Opera House, the Place de la Concorde, the Champs Elysees, Napoleon's great Arc de Triomphe, Les Invalides, and the Eiffel Tower. Visit the impressive Notre Dame Cathedral. Also visit Sainte Chapelle and the Chapel of Our Lady of the Miraculous Medal, where Saint Catherine Labouré is entombed in a glass coffin. (B,D)

MON, MAY 22 – PARIS/NEW YORK

Your pilgrimage concludes as you board your return flight back to New York. (B)

RESERVATIONS, DEPOSITS AND FINAL PAYMENT: Reservations may be secured upon payment of a deposit of \$600 per person. No reservation is considered firm until deposit has been received. Your initial deposit payment shall be deemed to be an acceptance of all the terms of our General Conditions. Space is limited and offered on a first-come basis. A second deposit of \$1000 is due by November 1, 2016. (Total deposit required by 11/1/16 is \$1600). The balance of payment is due at Nawas Travel on January 13, 2017.

Nawas accepts Visa, Mastercard and American Express for balance/final payments only. Credit cards are not accepted for deposits. The price of the tour already includes a built-in discount of 3% for payments made by cash or check. There is no discount on credit card sales. Credit cards will only be accepted prior to the final payment due date. Credit card charges cannot be accepted over the telephone. Tour members who want to use a credit card for final payment should contact Nawas at the time final payment is due for further information.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: A U.S.A passport valid for at least 6 months after the return date of the trip is required to travel. It is the sole responsibility of the traveler to check their passport's expiration date. Non-U.S.A. citizens may require visas in addition to a valid passport. It is the sole responsibility of non-U.S.A. citizens (including green card holders) to ensure they have the required visas/travel documents for each country to be visited on their tour and for re-entry into the U.S.A. Visa fees (if any) are not included in the tour price.

THE TOUR PRICE INCLUDES:

AIR TRANSPORTATION: By any IATA/ARC air carrier or other scheduled jet carrier, in economy class, with flights and air routings at the discretion of the air carriers and Nawas and based on non-refundable bulk group fares. Cancellations made after air tickets have been issued are subject to full cancellation penalties as imposed by the airlines. We strongly recommend all tour members retain both their ticket receipts and boarding passes as copies of same cannot be provided. Airline tickets must bear your first, middle and last name as it appears on your passport. Seat assignments for group air arrangements are made at the discretion of the airlines. Nawas will endeavor to fulfill seat requests, but cannot guarantee the airline will honor these requests. Passengers must apply directly with the airline for frequent flyer mileage, awards are at the sole discretion of the airline. Nawas cannot guarantee specific seat assignments. Seat assignments will not be advised until check in at the airport. Nawas makes every effort to provide the lowest possible price on our group tours and therefore does not guarantee the most direct routing to/from your final destination. Nawas is not responsible if an airline cancels, reschedules or delays a flight for any reason. Nawas is not responsible for and will not provide any refund for portions of trips missed due to canceled, rescheduled or delayed flights by any carrier.

TAXES/AIRLINE SURCHARGES: U.S. departure taxes, overseas airport taxes, overseas local government taxes, security fees and airline imposed international surcharges are included (taxes/surcharges current estimate as of April 25, 2016 is \$660 per person). Future price increases may be applied due to additional costs as imposed by a supplier or governments.

SURFACE TRANSPORTATION: By deluxe motorcoach.

HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS: Accommodations are at first class/select hotels based on two persons sharing a twin bedded room with private bath. Nawas cannot guarantee roommates. A person taking a single room (subject to availability) must pay a supplement of \$1000.

MEALS: Breakfast daily (hot or cold buffet or full breakfast) and 11 dinners are included.

SIGHTSEEING: As specified in the itinerary using motorcoach transportation or other conveyances as required. Entrance fees and the services of local English-speaking drivers/guides are included.

TRANSFERS: Assistance and transfers from airports to hotels and vice versa in private motorcoach.
